If you are experiencing difficulties paying your rent, please call your local Income Management Team **Oswestry on 01691 677230 or Bridgnorth on 01746 335310**. They will listen to your concerns, offer advice with regards to benefits and other budgeting or debt issues you may have.

Rent is charged and must be paid on a Monday. If you wish to pay on any other day of the week, you should be paying for the following week in advance.

If you wish to pay your rent monthly, you should be paying one month in advance, our preferred method of payment is Direct Debit. Please contact the Income Management Team to set up a Direct Debit over the phone. We now offer any day, date or frequency to suit your payment method.

We work closely with SUSTAIN who can help you with tenancy support.

We also have our own Financial Inclusion Team who can offer support and advice with all aspects of your finances e.g. debt advice, maximising income, bank accounts, managing bills, budgeting skills and accessing cheaper gas, electric and oil.

You can pay your rent in the following ways:-
